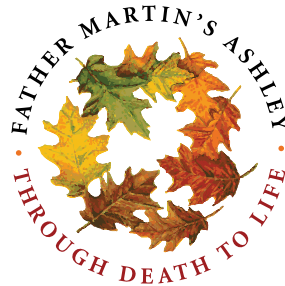

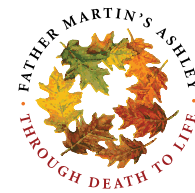

Mae Abraham’s Story

Born Lora Mae Ashley in 1927, Mae was one of 11 children of a Baptist minister. Married at age 19 to Tommy Abraham, and blaming herself for problems, Mae began to drink. Alcohol affected her immediately, causing violent illness, yet she was unable to stop drinking - even after the birth of her son.

Mae knew drinking was destroying her life. She tried unsuccessfully several times to stop. Then in 1964, Mae attended one of Fr. Martin’s Blackboard Talks which logically described the disease of alcoholism. She identified herself as an alcoholic and left the lecture empowered. She was ready to change her life.

Mae Abraham, along with Father Joseph C. Martin, S.S., founded Father Martin’s Ashley in 1983. Because of their dreams and determination, more than 30,000 addicts have been helped onto the path of recovery.
